Queensborough Greenways

2011

This project consisted of two major greenways in the Queensborough neighbourhood of New Westminster.

The first section of greenway along South Dyke Road between Thompson's Landing Park and Derwent Way is 1.6km in length and runs east west. It's design focused on creating a safe walking environment for residents, connecting the community with the river ecology, creating habitat and slope stabilization to the river's edge, and revealing the ecology and the history of the area through the use of interpretive signage.

Two other short greenway sections were built to connect the South Dyke Greenway to northerly greenways.

This project involved extensive consultation with the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, the Vancouver Port Authority, and the community through the format of public open houses.
